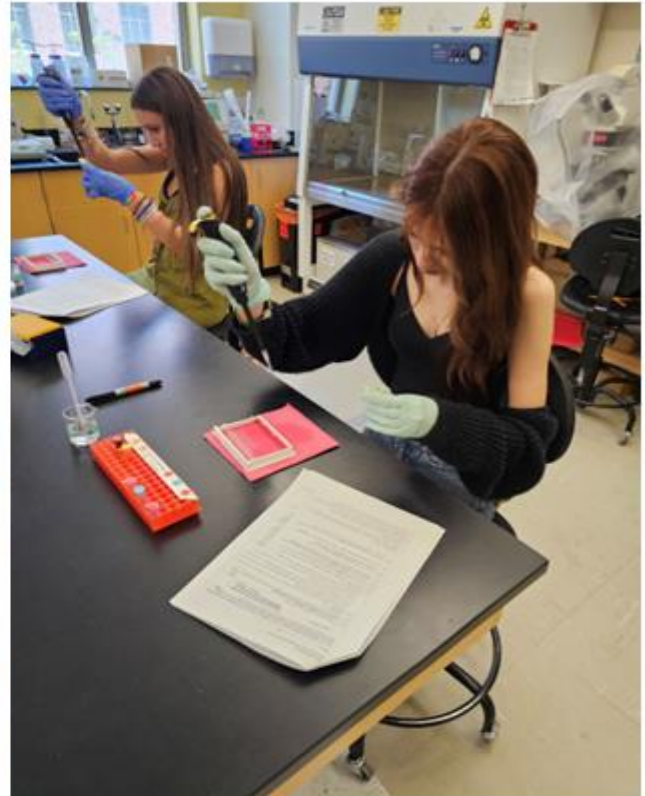

Dear Community Members,

Gerlach K-12 School wants to share a quick update about this year's Annual School Plant Sale. After much consideration, we have decided to postpone the sale until next year. We know this is a tradition many folks look forward to—whether as volunteers, customers, or both—and we are so grateful for the support you've shown over the years.

The good news is that we're not stepping back—we're stepping forward. Our school is currently working to outfit the greenhouse so it can support growing year-round. Up until now, we have only used it for a few months each spring, just enough to grow plants for the sale. With year-round use, we are aiming to grow fresh vegetables, herbs, and teas that can be more regularly available to our community.

Living more than 80 miles from the nearest full-service grocery store means fresh produce isn't always easy to come by. We are hopeful that the greenhouse can, over time, become part of a solution.

As we move into this new chapter, we'd love to welcome a small group of community volunteers to help us get things off the ground. Whether you've got gardening experience, an interest in local food, or just some time and a willingness to pitch in, there will be lots of ways to be involved—from sharing advice to planting and harvesting. We will keep you updated as the greenhouse comes to life and look forward to bringing the Gerlach School Plant Sale back next year—stronger than ever.

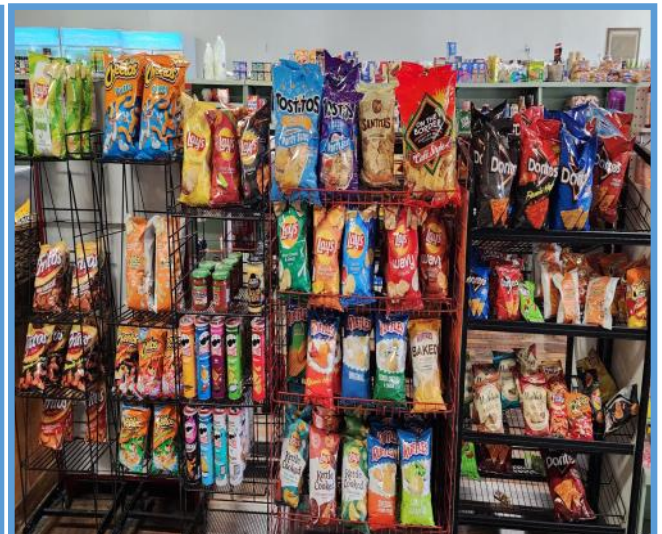
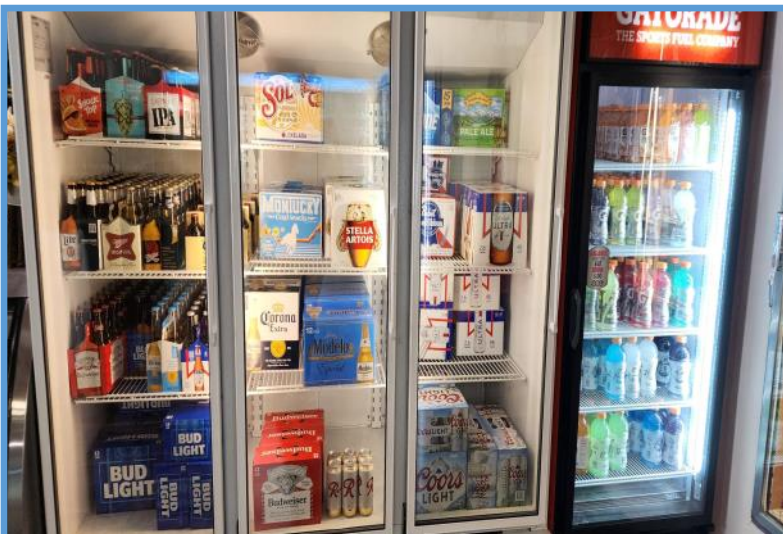
